

Case Study

Our company was briefed to design and install an extraction system to expel the smoke and fumes from a forge training table in a working Museum.

As part of a multi-million pound refurbishment the Museum has a new craftsman workshop where the skill of Blacksmithing is taught to local students.

A stainless steel fume canopy was positioned directly above the forge training table with removable hanging screens. The screens can be removed when each fire pit is in use, however, when not all in use this provides a faster, more efficient airflow across the table top.









The client was overwhelmed with the extraction system as it was much quieter than any previous system that they had used and was complimentary to the aesthetically pleasing Museum grounds.
