Our Company was approached to design and install five exhaust extraction systems for a Bus Maintenance Depot.

Space was at a premium and the client required an extraction system that protected workers from exhaust fumes but also one that didn't get in the way of operations.

Manual hose reels were installed at each maintenance bay to enable quick connection to vehicles via clamp nozzles to the vehicle exhausts.

Even though engine standards become ever more stringent, extraction systems are still required to remove harmful exhaust fumes and protect persons in an enclosed space.
