

Case Study

Our Company was approached to design and install two exhaust extraction systems for a Bus Maintenance Depot.

As the two garages were each only small enough for one bus to be housed, reels were not really an option as there was barely enough room to manoeuvre around a vehicle when in situ.

Thus single point hoses with nozzles were utilized, these were connected to centrifugal fans which expelled exhaust fumes to atmosphere.

J Hooks were used to enable exhaust extraction hoses to be stowed when not in use.



Even though engine standards become ever more stringent, extraction systems are still required to remove harmful exhaust fumes and protect persons in an enclosed space.
